The Heavens Declare

"The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork."

- Psalm 19:1

In case you missed it, there is a solar eclipse tomorrow. I don't know how you could have missed it. I have seen it on the news and on social media. I have notices from the school about viewing the eclipse. I have heard reports of people preparing to travel hundreds of miles to see the effects of the eclipse. There are places getting ready for an influx of those travelers. The movement of the moon in front of the sun has affected businesses, families, local government actions, and national media outlets. It is a phenomenon!

Personally, I am excited to be a part of this time. I am excited about the science lessons that will be taught and the young, eager minds that will learn. I am excited to see people moved by something natural. I am excited that talk has turned from trouble to anticipation. I am excited that we are reminded not only of the force of nature but of the power of God.

The Bible has a lot to say about how nature, especially the heavens, declares the glory of God. Genesis 1:16 teaches us that the sun and moon that hold such a fascination for man this week are created by God. Psalm 19:4-6 celebrates the fact that the sun's journey across the sky each day is a picture of God's watchful eye and sovereign power over the earth and humanity. Ecclesiastes 1:5 tells us that the movement of the heavenly bodies is constant and predictable. A reflection of God's character. Malachi 4:2 teaches us to see the promise of God for salvation and renewal in the rising of the sun. Matthew 5:45 uses the example of the rising sun to show us God's benevolence, patience, and continuing invitation. In many ways, what we see in the sky each day is a testimony to our Creator and His work in the world.

As we look up tomorrow to pay special attention to the sky, we Christians are reminded of Revelation 22:5. What we see tomorrow is a powerful event, but it is part of the passing time on earth. There will come a day when we stand in a light greater than the sun. We will stand in the light of God's presence, and the sun will no longer shine; the Lord will be our light.

Tomorrow, we will begin in light, move through darkness, and experience the joy of returning light. Let it be a reminder of what God does every day in the life of mankind. As the world looks toward the sky, they will see science, a bit of mystical history, and events that alter the movement of mankind, if even for a short time. Remember that in this moment, God is moving, and the world is watching. Let it be a reminder to let Jesus shine in your life. That is an event worth watching every single day!
