September 28, 2025

Thoughtful, Prayerful, and Biblical

This morning marks an important moment in the life of our congregation: the beginning of the process of selecting additional elders to shepherd the flock of God at Spring Creek. Scripture reminds us that leadership in the church is no casual matter. The apostle Paul told Titus to "appoint elders in every town" (Titus 1:5), underscoring that every congregation needs godly men who will guide, protect, and nurture God's people.

As we enter this time, we must first be **thoughtful**. Choosing elders is not about popularity or personality. It is about character and Christlikeness. Paul gives clear qualities in passages such as 1 Timothy 3:1-7 and Titus 1:6-9. These are not boxes to check but Spirit-inspired descriptions of the kind of men who can help us grow into maturity in Christ. Take time to carefully read and reflect on these passages.

We must also be **prayerful**. This process is not simply an administrative task; it is a spiritual work. James reminds us, "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all" (James 1:5). Pray for wisdom. Pray for humility. Pray for the men who may be considered and for their families. Pray that the Lord will raise up shepherds after His own heart (Jeremiah 3:15).

Finally, we must be **biblical**. Our decisions must be rooted in God's Word, not swayed by culture, convenience, or personal preference. The church belongs to Christ. He "purchased [it] with his own blood" (Acts 20:28). Therefore, our responsibility is to honor His design for leadership and submit to His will as revealed in Scripture.

Every member has a vital role to play in this process. Please take part. Read. Pray. Consider. Submit names with a spirit of unity and love. By participating faithfully, you help ensure that this congregation is led by men who will point us all to Jesus, the Chief Shepherd (1 Peter 5:4). ~Bill
