Prayer Is the Work

Learning to pray the way Jesus prayed

Prayer is often the first thing we believe in and the last thing we actually practice.

It quietly gets pushed to the edges of our day. We pray before meals. We pray when something goes wrong. We pray when we need help. But prayer easily becomes something we do *around* life instead of something that shapes life.

Oswald Chambers once wrote something that exposes how many of us quietly think about prayer:

“We think of prayer as a preparation for work, or a calm after having done work, whereas prayer is the essential work.” — Oswald Chambers, *If Ye Shall Ask*

That sentence challenges the way many of us approach our relationship with God.

We often assume the real work is the meeting, the task, the responsibility, or the decision. Prayer becomes the warm-up or the closing moment. Yet Scripture paints a different picture.

Jesus prayed constantly. Before major decisions, He prayed (Luke 6:12). In moments of pressure, He withdrew to pray (Luke 5:16). In His darkest hour, He prayed (Matthew 26:36–39). Prayer was not an occasional activity in the life of Jesus. Prayer was the rhythm of His life.

We look more like Jesus when we pray like Jesus.

Prayer becomes the quiet center of a disciple's life. It is where our hearts are aligned with God's will. It is where pride softens. It is where fear is surrendered. It is where trust grows.

Paul wrote simply, “Pray without ceasing” (1 Thessalonians 5:17).

So pause for a moment this week and consider your own life.

Is prayer the background of your life, or the center of it?

Disciples of Jesus do not squeeze prayer into their schedules. They build their lives around it.
