Responding to the Language of Violence

Another act of violence has entered our national story. It is one of the many that we see far too regularly in our news cycles.

Each time this happens, something subtle but dangerous follows close behind it. Not just fear. Not just grief. But the temptation for God’s people is to begin speaking the same language as the world around them. Language that reacts with anger for anger, suspicion for suspicion, and outrage for outrage.

Scripture calls us to something different.

“The anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God” (James 1:20).

Violence always tries to recruit us. It asks us to take sides quickly, speak quickly, judge quickly, and harden our hearts quickly. But followers of Jesus are not called to be loudest in the moment. We are called to be faithful in the moment.

Our citizenship is not anchored in a party, an ideology, or a news cycle. “Our citizenship is in heaven” (Philippians 3:20). That means we refuse to celebrate harm, excuse hatred, or treat enemies as less than people made in the image of God.

The church must never become a place where the spirit of the age feels at home.

Instead, we become people who pray when others rage. People who tell the truth when others exaggerate. People who seek peace when others choose sides.

This is not weakness. It is discipleship.

The world will continue to reach for violence as a solution. But the people of Christ are called to show that there is another way to live and another King we follow.

And in moments like these, that witness matters more than ever.
