### Thank God for Mothers

Mother's Day gives us the opportunity to pause and say something that is too easy to overlook in the busyness of everyday life: Thank God for mothers.

From the beginning, God designed families as places where faith could be nurtured, character formed, and love practiced daily. Again and again in Scripture, we see the quiet strength and lasting influence of faithful mothers. Timothy's sincere faith, for example, first lived in his grandmother Lois and his mother Eunice (2 Timothy 1:5). Long before Timothy became a servant of the church, he was shaped by women who loved God and lived what they believed.

That story is still being repeated today.

Mothers teach us how to pray before we know what prayer means. They show us how to care before we understand sacrifice. For mothers who helped us see something of the heart of God.
