Seeing Jesus

There is something wonderfully honest about the request found in John 12:21. A group of Greeks approached the disciples and simply said, “Sir, we wish to see Jesus.”

Not debate religion.
Not win an argument.
Not impress anyone.
They wanted to see Jesus.

I suspect that longing still lives in people today, even if they struggle to put it into words. Beneath the noise, stress, disappointment, and hurry of life, people are still searching for something real, steady, and full of grace. They are still searching for Jesus.

The remarkable thing is that Jesus is often seen in ordinary moments.

He is seen in the kindness of a Christian who notices someone hurting.

He is seen in a prayer whispered over a hospital bed.

He is seen in forgiveness offered when bitterness would be easier.

He is seen in families who choose love, in servants who quietly help others, and in believers who carry peace into anxious places.

Most of life is not lived in spectacular moments. It is lived in everyday moments. Yet those ordinary places can become holy ground when we learn to recognize the presence of God within them.

Perhaps one of the greatest callings of the Christian life is simply this: to live in such a way that when people encounter us, they catch a glimpse of Jesus.

This week, slow down enough to notice Him. You may discover that God is nearer than you think.
