Gratitude Grows From Remembrance

As our nation approaches the celebration of its 250th birthday, there will be plenty of opportunities to remember. Fireworks, parades, family gatherings, old photographs, and stories from generations past all remind us where we have come from. Remembering has a way of shaping gratitude.

The Bible reminds God's people to remember as well. Moses told Israel, "Remember the whole way that the Lord your God has led you" (Deuteronomy 8:2). Before they looked ahead, they were first invited to look back. They were to remember God's provision, His patience, His discipline, and His unfailing presence.
