Learning

This week at JAM Camp, I had the opportunity to teach a few sessions with our campers. Teaching children is different from teaching adults, but I was reminded once again that some of life's greatest lessons are wonderfully simple.

One afternoon we played "Everybody's It," a game that taught the importance of watching out for one another. If someone was tagged and frozen, another camper could set them free. We talked about Philippians 2:4 and the importance of looking not only to our own interests, but also to the interests of others.

Another day we played the old game "Telephone." The laughter came easily as the message changed from one end of the line to the other, but it also reminded us how important it is to communicate clearly. We talked about the message God has entrusted to us—the good news that He loves us, seeks us, and rejoices when people come home to Him (Luke 15).

The campers learned those lessons well. But if I'm honest, I think I learned just as much.

Children have a wonderful way of reminding us what following Jesus looks like. They forgive quickly. They laugh freely. They welcome others. They encourage one another. They are eager to learn and quick to serve. Their faith is still growing, but it is genuine, joyful, and contagious.

As I returned home from camp, I found myself grateful not only for the opportunity to teach these young hearts, but also for the privilege of learning from them. Jesus once told His disciples to become like little children. This week, I was reminded why. Sometimes one of the best ways to grow in our own faith is to spend time with someone whose joy in following Jesus is still wonderfully uncomplicated.
