Make Room

Now that Labor Day has come and gone, I think all of our kiddos have started school. Families are settling into familiar routines, and I am reminded that most of us know what it feels like to have a full life. Our calendars fill quickly. There are places to go, things to accomplish, and people who need us. Before long, even good things can leave very little room for anyone we weren't already expecting.

The writer of Hebrews tells us, “Let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works” (Hebrews 10:24). I like that word *consider*. It asks us to slow down long enough to notice another person and think intentionally about how we might encourage them toward Jesus.

Christian community begins there. It grows when we make room for one another: room for a conversation after worship, room at the table, room to listen to someone's story, room in our routines for relationships that help us grow in Christ.

Community begins when we make room for another person.

This week, make room for one intentional conversation. Sit with someone. Stay a few minutes longer. Ask a real question and listen to the answer. You don't have to say anything profound. Just give someone the gift of your attention. You may discover that making room in a crowded life creates room for a relationship to grow. ~ Bill
